Who: **Scott McNulty** joined the BWC/OSHA On-Site as an Industrial Safety Consultant in 2013. Before that, Scott worked for over 13 years in Occupational Safety and Health. Scott got his start in safety while working for the United States Air Force (U.S.A.F.) as Ground Safety Technician. After retiring from the U.S.A.F. he worked for Cuyahoga County as their Safety & Health Coordinator. In 2007, Scott became a compliance Officer with the Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA). While at OSHA he conducted nearly 500 inspections including accidents and fatalities. In 2010, Scott had the first egregious construction case in the Cleveland Area OSHA Office which involved a fatality of a worker that became trapped in a trench cave-in. Scott holds a Bachelor's of Science Degree in Management from Newman University and an Associate's Degree in Occupational Safety and Health from the Community College of the United States Air Force.
